Release Date

It is recommended to complete this step after finding the "Seller".

Definition:

"The time, as the day, part of the day, and sometimes the hour, on or at which release copy may be products get released." https://www.dictionary.com/browse/release-date

Guidance:

Enter the date on which the item has been released.

Date Form - Input the date as MM/DD/YYYY, if the day is not known use MM/YYYY and if month and day are unknown use YYYY.

Examples – 10/20/2003 10/2003 2003

If no date can be found input the date as MM/DD/YYYY. Do not use 00 as month or day if no month or day can be found.

Edition

It is recommended to complete this step after finding the "Seller".

Definition:

"The forms in which something is presented - **Exclusive vs Limited Edition.**" https://www.merriam-webster.com/dictionary/edition

- "Exclusive means it can only be purchased in a specific store or place."
- "Limited means there's a certain amount made and that's it."

Guidance:

Record the figures as **Limited Edition**, **or** (**first**, **second**, **third**, **etc...**) **Edition** or ****Exclusive**. If an edition cannot be found use **Unknown** or if there are no editions use "**no edition**".

**NOTE: If an item is Exclusive record the seller it is exclusive to as "(seller name) exclusive."

DO NOT use (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th) spell out the words First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth

Examples-

Limited Edition Second Edition Fifth Edition

Guidelines:

No specific guidelines were used.

Condition "C-Scale"

Definition:

The "C" scale rates condition on a scale of one to 10, with a C10 rating indicating high quality and a C1 rating indicating poor quality.

Examples-

C10 = Mint Condition.

C8-9 = Near Mint Condition.

C6-7 = Fine Condition.

C4-5 = Good Condition.

C2-3 = Poor Condition.

C1 = Very Poor.

Guidance:

Record the physical condition for the action figures using the c-scale figure grading system guide located in the <u>Guidelines Used</u> section below.
